WHAT IS ROOTED IN RELATIONSHIPS?


Rooted in Relationships is an initiative that partners with communities to implement evidence based practices that enhance the social-emotional development of children, birth through age 8.

WHAT IS THE PYRAMID MODEL?

The Pyramid Model is a framework of evidencebased practices for promoting young children's healthy social and emotional development.

It builds upon a tiered public health approach to providing universal strategies for all children to promote wellness, targeted services to those who need more support, and intensive services to those who need them.

- · Children's challenging behaviors
- · Family and staff turnover

- Family and staff satisfaction
- Caregiver knowledge and confidence in supporting children and families
- Positive program changes, including overall quality of care



WHAT ARE THE REQUIREMENTS TO PARTICIPATE?

- · 3 Year commitment
- · Monthly coaching
- Required trainings that are approved for NDE Professional Development Hours
- · Provider collaboration meetings
- · Participation in evaluation of the program

WHAT'S IN IT FOR ME?

- Stipends to attend each training session and participate in monthly coaching
- · Access to additional social emotional grants
- Reduced challenging behaviors in your child care center or family child care home
- The opportunity to connect with other providers, coaches, and others in the community who support and value the work you do!
